TIME TO RELAX!

Directions To Fun Fore All from the Doubletree Hotel

Via the Pennsylvania Turnpike: Take US Business Route 22 east (turn right off of Mall Boulevard) for just under 2 miles to the Pennsylvania Turnpike via an exit to the right. Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-76/ toll road) west to toll gate where all vehicles must pay (express EZ Pass is to the far left). Exit at Cranberry (Exit #28) and follow signs for Route 19 north, which requires turning right at the end of the exit ramp. Follow Route 19 north through 8 traffic signals and get in the left lane. When you see Dairy Queen on the right, the Fun Fore All pirate ship will be visible on top of the hill on the left. At this point, merge into the turning lane and turn left onto Progress Avenue at the Fun Fore All sign. Turn right into the parking lot. The approximate drive time is 40 minutes.

Via I-376 & I-279: Take US Business Route 22 west and follow it to I-376 west (left lane ramp) toward Pittsburgh. Exit at Boulevard of the Allies (Exit #72B). Once on Boulevard of the Allies, merge into the right lane and follow it to I-579 north. (The ramp to I-579 north is in the downtown area. Be cautious not to take any of the downtown exits to the left or right. Follow signs for I-579 north, I-279 north and Veterans Bridge). I-579 north will take you across the Veteran's Bridge. Once on the Veteran's Bridge, merge to the left and at the end of the bridge merge onto I-279 north. Follow I-279 north until it ends and merges onto I-79 north. Exit at the Cranberry exit (Exit #76; a left lane exit) onto Route 19 north. Follow Route 19 north through 10 traffic signals and get in the left lane. When you see Dairy Queen on the right, the Fun Fore All pirate ship will be visible on top of the hill on the left. At this point, merge into the turning lane and turn left onto Progress Avenue at the Fun Fore All sign. Turn right into the parking lot. The approximate drive time is 40 minutes, but can vary with traffic, especially during rush hour.

Directions to Conneaut Lake Park from Fun Fore All

From Fun Fore All: Turn left out of Fun Fore All's parking lot onto Progress Avenue, then left onto Route 19 north. Follow Route 19 north for 4.7 miles and merge to the right onto I-79 north. Follow I-79 north and exit at PA Route 285 (Exit #141) toward Geneva/Cochran. At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto PA Route 285 west and follow it for 8.7 miles. Turn left onto PA Route 6/US Route 322 and follow for one mile. Make a slight right onto PA Route 618 north and follow it for just over two miles. The park will be on your right with the main parking lot on your left. The approximate travel time is 1 hour, 20 minutes.
